Dear Board,

Thank you for granting my request to ask ENR for certain additional documents. Unfortunately, the most important request, the one for complete collaring information, was not granted. I would like to ask the board to reconsider their denial. The biologists the interveners have been working with consider this to be the most critical information of all. Surely, the WRRB biologist would come to the same conclusion.

The interveners have been promised, by all the parties, a transparent process. Mr. Ernie Campbell, Assistant Deputy Minister, has promised this collaring information to the interveners on numerous occasions. Minister Miltenberger, ENR minister, has promised to follow the ARC Review, which recommended a transparent process.

I am willing to forego some of the other documentation, such as department emails, payments to individuals, etc., as that can all be gotten later, in the discovery process. The location of collared caribou, however, is clearly information this board needs to make a proper determination of what herds, and therefore, what wildlife, is in Wek'eezhi. The board is mandated to manage all caribou herds in Wek'eezhi, and not just the Bathurst caribou herd.

If this second request is denied, I would ask the board for clear and concise reasons for the denial.
