2.1 Review & Approval of Wildlife Research Permit Application – Collaring of Bathurst Barren-ground Caribou in Fall (October) Using Net-Gun Capture

As the attempts to collar Kok'èetì Ekwò (Bathurst Caribou) in March and July 2024 had limited success, GNWT-ECC is proposing to capture Kok'èetì ekwò in Fall 2024 (October-November). Since 2020, collar locations of Kok'èetì, Sahtì, and Beverly ekwò during the fall rut season (late October) have shown limited overlap, thus there is high potential to target Kok'èetì ekwò at this time of year.

The Wildlife Research Proposal application, submitted to the WRRB on September 5, 2024, details that a) deploy up to 40 collars (30 on cows and 10 on bulls) on the Kǫk'èetì ekwò herd only. These collars would be a part of the already approved 70 Bathurst maximum collar (50 cow, 20 bull); b) collars will be deployed in areas having only existing collared Kǫk'èetì ekwò nearby; c) capture will occur by net gun from a helicopter with an experienced gunner; d) as there is unlikely to be deep snow, crew will avoid rugged terrain to limit the likelihood of injuring caribou; and, e) collaring will occur between October 15 and November 15, 2024. An NWT Wildlife Care Committee permit has been applied for, but that ECC does not yet have an active permit.

Satellite collars are essential for the Mobile Core Bathurst Caribou Management Zone, the only current method to measure immigration and emigration, and is aligned with recommendations for enhanced monitoring of the Kǫk'èetì ekwǫ. Discussions included confirmation of existing Kǫk'èetì ekwǫ collars (24 active collars, 18 cows, 6 bulls), the number of collars used for the mobile zone in Jan – Mar 2024 (30 collars at beginning of harvest season, fewer by mid-season, 50km buffer), cow collar allocations occur following calving, concerns noted by Tłįchǫ citizens about miscommunication (seeing thousands of caribou but not able to harvest), and how to manage Kǫk'èetì ekwǫ protection if unable to use mobile zone (static map, no mobile zone).

2.2 Review & Approval of Wildlife Research Permit Application – Mackenzie Bison Collaring Program 2024-28

On August 19, 2024, ECC-GNWT submitted a Wildlife Research Permit Application to the WRRB, proposing a collaring program on the Mackenzie Ejie (Wood Bison) subpopulation, with collaring deployments occurring in fall 2024 to winter 2025. The management proposal summary includes the following: a) 2.5-year collars which must be removed by recapture, b) deploy up to 15 adult female collars, c) ground (by road) or helicopter captures may occur, d) capture will occur by darting and anesthetizing ejie, and e) ejie will be woken up by another drug combination. There is an active NWT Wildlife Care Committee (WCC) permit for this work.

Collaring has been recommended by the Mackenzie Bison Working Group, in the *Mackenzie Bison Management Plan*, and collaring will help identify critical

habitat, locate ejie for surveys, help correct populations surveys, and better inform habitat use. Discussions included updates to existing maps in the management plan (5-year review), current number of ejie collared (13 cows).

 - 6.1 Set Date for Review of Sahtì Ekwò Joint Management Proposal

The record for the Sahtì Ekwò Management Proceeding closed on October 9, 2024. Closing arguments were received from the sole participant, Nunavut Wildlife Management Board, on October 16, 2024 and from TG and GNWT on October 18, 2024. The Board must now review the evidence on record and discuss the proposed management actions identified: 1) proposed increase in TAH from 193 to 395, and 2) proposed change in calving ground survey interval from every two years to every three years (from 2025 onwards).

Board Members agreed to meet virtually via Zoom on November 12, 2024. Following the meeting, Board staff will draft a reasons for decision report for final review and approval at the December 17-18, 2024 meeting.
