2.0 Business

- 2.1 Appoint Interim Chairperson
 - Term Dates for WRRB Board Members January 2015 tabled

Until a Chair is appointed, a Board Member must act as the Interim Chair. Grant Pryznyk has acted as Interim Chair since August 2013. In July 2014, the Board informed Environment Canada (EC), Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO), and the Department of Environment & Natural Resources (ENR), Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) that their nominees' appointments (Bruce MacDonald, Grant Pryznyk and Steven Matthews) were due to expire in 2015. Both EC and DFO forwarded the names of Bruce MacDonald and Grant Pryznyk, respectively, to Indigenous & Northern Affairs Canada (INAC; formerly Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada) for reappointment to the WRRB in December 2014. To date, no response has received. To date, GNWT has not forwarded a name for appointment.

On October 2, 2015, Grant Pryznyk's term expired. Steven Matthew and Bruce MacDonald's terms end on November 28 and December 7, 2015, respectively. The Board must appoint a new Interim Chair; Grant may continue with the Board as a Special Representative but may not vote.

2015/2016 Interim Recommendations

To date, the Board has not received a response from ENR and TG on the interim recommendations.

2015 Bluenose-East Caribou Population Estimate

During the week of October 26, 2015, ENR was able to conduct the required composition survey for the Bluenose-East caribou herd. Despite long daily ferry trips to the north end of Great Bear Lake, the ENR crew was able to classify 4300 caribou (57 groups). The bull to cow ratio was 42:100 and calf to cow ratio was 35:100. Based on this survey and the calving ground information from June 2015, the 2015 population estimate is 38,592 (CI=33,859-43,325) 1.5+ year old caribou.

Joint Management Proposals

On October 15, 2015, ENR and TG proposed a revised submission date for the Bathurst and Bluenose-East caribou herds joint management proposals from October 15 and November 15, respectively, to December 15, 2015. The request was to accommodate consultation requirements of both governments. It was further noted that a draft of the joint management proposals was targeted for November 15, 2015. On October 21, 2015, the Board acknowledged receipt and acceptance of ENR and TG's letter of October 15, 2015. It was requested that, due to concerns about future timing issues, the draft joint management proposals be shared confidentially with the WRRB to allow for Staff review. To date, there has been no further response.

Proceedings Preparations

On October 1, 2015, the Board forwarded its Rules of Procedure and Rule for Management Proposals to the Parties of the Tłįchǫ Agreement. As well, both Rules were posted to the WRRB's website, under Public Information, Guidelines and Forms.

On October 27-28, 2015, the SRRB and WRRB (Chairs, Executive Directors and Legal Counsel) met to sign the "Memorandum of Understanding Regarding Collaborative Efforts for the Management of the Bluenose-East Caribou Herd" and to discuss the logistics of a collaborative process. On November 6, 2015, the SRRB and WRRB provided a copy of the signed MOU to governments and co-management authorities. As well, the MOU and a short news item were posted to the WRRB's website, under Public Information, Guidelines and Forms, and on Facebook.

In further preparation for the Bathurst and Bluenose-East caribou herds' proceedings, WRRB Legal Counsel, John Donihee, suggested the development of a work plan for each joint management proposal that outlines the processes and timelines to be followed. The work plan will be posted to the public registry once a proceeding is called following approval by the Board and Legal Counsel. The Board will review the work plan periodically during the proceeding and adjust as required.

A concern about the November 23, 2015 territorial election and possible change in ENR Minister was raised; it was noted that due to requirements of the Tłįchǫ Agreement, the joint management proposals and the subsequent processes will go ahead in 2016 despite a possible change in ENR Minister.

A reporting requirement of the WRRB's contribution agreement with Canada is to provide an annual interim activity report that details how its obligations have been met as outlined in the original budget and work plan and any changes that are to be expected. In addition, Staff took the opportunity to remind Canada of the Board's need for funding for public hearings related to the expected submission of the Bathurst and Bluenose-East caribou herds' joint management proposals. The Board also reminded Canada of funding requests submitted in July 2015 for the website/public registry upgrade and Species at Risk consultations for the Boreal Caribou.
