



NOTICE OF REVISED PROCEEDING SCHEDULE – BLUENOSE-EAST CARIBOU HERD

On December 15, 2015, the Tłı̨chq̓ Government (TG) and Department of Environment & Natural Resources (ENR), Government of Northwest Territories submitted the “*Joint Proposal on Management Actions for Bluenose-East Caribou 2016-2019*” to the Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) outlining proposed management actions for the Bluenose-East Caribou Herd in Wek'èezhì. The Board opened the 2016 Bluenose-East Caribou Herd Proceeding on January 18, 2016, and held a public hearing on April 6-8, 2016 in Behchokò, NT.

In order to allow careful consideration of all of the information on the record and to meet legislated timelines, the WRRB decided that prioritization and organization of its decisions and recommendations was necessary; therefore, the Board prepared two separate reports to respond to the proposed Bluenose-East caribou management actions in the joint management proposal. The Bluenose-East Caribou Herd Reasons for Decision report, Part A, was submitted to TG and ENR on June 13, 2016.

The WRRB advises you of the following revised Proceeding Schedule. In order for all evidence on the public record to be fully considered, the Board has extended its submission date of its Reasons for Decision report, Part B to TG and ENR by ten working days.
