Re: Tłıchq Government, Tłıchq Fiber Optic Line Project – Wildlife Management & Monitoring Plan

Dear Ms. Duncan;

During their recent May 2021 meeting, the Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) reviewed Tłıchq Government's Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan (WMMP), Version 2.0 for the Tłıchq Fiber Optic Line Project. The Board understands that the Tłıchq Government is constructing a fiber optic line along the Tłıchq Highway route. As the Project may impact wildlife and wildlife habitat, a WMMP was developed for the project.

The Tłıchq Government submitted Version 1.0 of the WMMP to the Wek'èezhì Land and Water Board (WLWB) in March 2021. WRRB staff provided comments and had the comments followed up with via email by Tłıchq Government contractor, Peter Kiewit Sons (ULC), and on the WLWB's Online Review System. Version 2.0 of the WMMP was submitted to the WRRB on April 26, 2021.

Following discussion, the WRRB approves the WMMP, Version 2.0 for the Tłıchq Fiber Optic Line Project as presented since the Tłıchq Government has adequately addressed all of the concerns identified in the WMMP, Version 1.0 (Motion #773-26-05-2021).
